- Only grades earned at Creighton Prep are calculated into the GPA.

HONORS AND A.P. COURSES

Honors Courses

English (English I, English II), Math (College Algebra, Geometry, Pre-calculus), Science (Integrated Science, Biology, Chemistry, Physics), and World Languages (Latin II and III, Spanish II and III, French II, III, and IV), Fine Arts (Concert Winds, Concert Percussion, Chamber Choir).

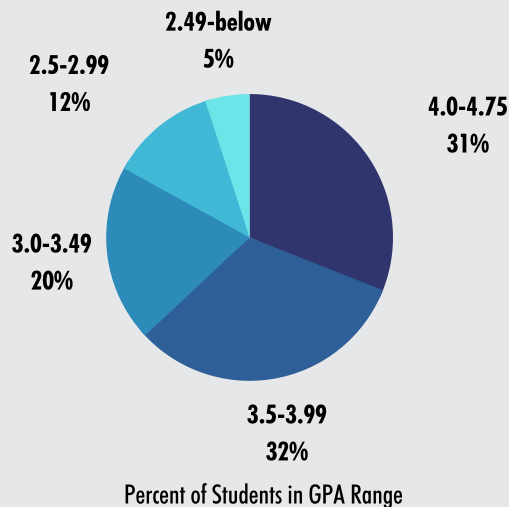
A.P. Courses

English (Language and Composition, Literature and Composition), Math (Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Statistics), Science (Biology, Chemistry, Physics I, Physics C), Social Studies (U.S. History, Human Geography, American Government, Microeconomics, World History, Psychology), World Languages (Latin IV, Spanish Language & Culture, French Language & Culture), Fine Arts (Drawing, Photography) and Technology (Computer Science).

Students are not restricted in the number of honors and A.P. courses they may select.

COLLEGE CREDIT

Students may earn college credit in one of two ways: They may take the AP exam or they may co-register for credit through the applicable department at: Creighton University (AP Physics C, Intro to Coding), Nebraska Wesleyan University (AP Microeconomics, College Composition, World Religions), or the University of Nebraska-Omaha (AP Biology, AP Calculus AB, AP Calculus BC, AP Computer Science A, AP English Lit and Comp, AP Latin IV, AP Statistics, AP Studio Art, AP U.S. History, Calculus I and III, Differential Equations, Honors Calculus II/III, Honors Physics, Independent Study Art, and Information Security).



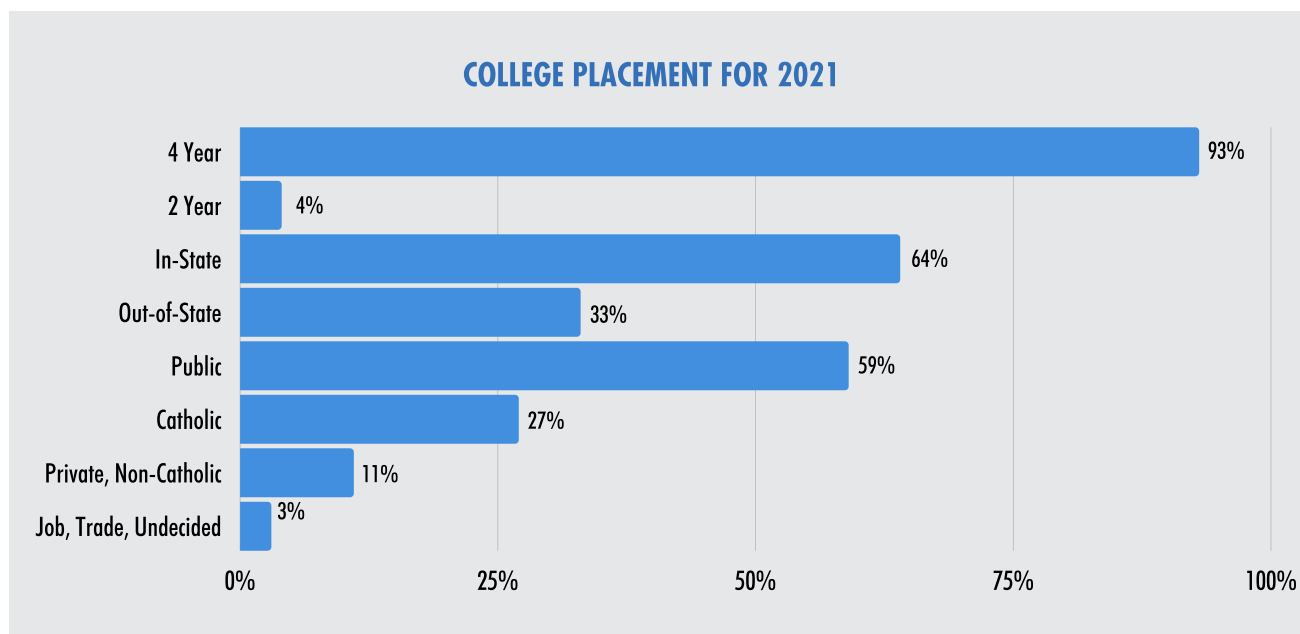
PANDEMIC & STATISTICAL INFORMATION

PANDEMIC RESPONSE

On March 16, 2020, Creighton Preparatory School went to 100% remote learning for the remainder of the school year. Students participated in classes via Zoom and completed coursework and assessments through Canvas and other web-based tools. We completed all required instructional hours. For the 2020-21 school year, we had three learning options.

- Level 1 was full in-person attendance.
- Level 2 was a hybrid model with half of the students in person and the other half remote, with students rotating on a two-day basis.
- Level 3 was 100% remote.

Creighton Preparatory School followed guidelines from the Douglas County Health Department and the Department of Education. School began at Level 2. On February 8, 2021, the school progressed to Level 1. Students were given the option to learn remotely with administrative approval. The 2021-22 school year is beginning at Level 1. Remote learning is not an option.
